GCSE Results Summary 2016

Our headline measure of 2A*-C in English and Maths was 81% which is significantly above the national average, the highest in the 15 Tameside schools, the highest in the school's history and in the top 10% nationally. The outgoing measure of 5 GCSEs at grades A*-C including English and Maths was the highest in the school's history and the highest in the 15 Tameside schools.

Progress 8 is the new government measure of school performance. A link explaining this in more detail is available at the bottom of this page. Our Progress 8 score is above zero at +0.03. This ranks us in the top 47% of schools in the country. When contextualised our Progress 8 increased to +0.15 which is in the top 29% of schools nationally (please note boys Progress 8 nationally is -0.12 and girls is +0.13).
