Year 10 Art students receive 5 lessons of Art per fortnight throughout the full year.

Students will complete up to three main projects which will form 60% of their final GCSE grade.

Autumn Term

Animals Project - During the project students will:

- Create a series of drawings of animals using a range of media including pencil and tone, pencil crayon, pen, oil pastels, water colour and acrylic paint.
- Research a range of artists and art movements which could include, Iain Macarthur, Ola Liola, Kris Tate, Abby Diamond, Mark Powell, Hua Tunan and other artists.
- Develop and explore ideas independently, using a range of appropriate materials and surfaces which could include, fine liner, inks, paint, pencil, pencil crayon.
- Present a personal final outcome.

EXTRA CURRICULAR – Lunchtime and afterschool coursework club.

Spring Term

Indian Art Project - During the project students will:

- Record observations through photography and a range of drawing techniques.
- Research into Indian art and patterns and the work of other relevant artists.
- Develop and explore ideas independently, experimenting with pattern, repeating patterns and using a range of appropriate materials which could include, fine liner, white and metallic pens, inks, paint, pencil crayon, printing, silk painting and Photoshop.
- Present a series of Mandala final outcomes.

Summer Term

Architecture Project - During the project students will:

- Record observations through photography and a range of drawing techniques.
- Research a range of artists, art movements which could include, Ian Murphy, Ian Fennelly, Minty Sainsbury, Kyle Henderson, Rowan Leckie and other artists.
- Develop and explore ideas independently, experimenting with mixed media surfaces, fine liner, inks, paint, pencil crayon, mono printing.
- Present a personal final outcome.

EXTRA CURRICULAR – Trip to Saltaire/Quarry Bank Mill. Trip to MMU Foundation and Degree Shows (SMSC) (Careers/ aspirations). Lunchtime and afterschool coursework club.

ASSESSMENT – Coursework pieces will be assessed as they are completed and all assessments will be recorded in student's individual assessment booklets with a grade and clear next step.
