Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year from myself, the governors, and the whole staff body at Audenshaw School. I do hope this correspondence finds you well and in good health after what I hope was a relaxing break.

Last term I hope you managed to access the Principal's Update. This was delivered by members of my Senior Leadership Team during half term two. Students have started the new term extremely well! I know I speak on behalf of all colleagues when I say just how brilliant it was to hear first-hand of the joyful festive break experienced by so many of our students. We are very much 'back to it' now and look forward to having an excellent term ahead as we continue to work in partnership to build 'exceptional young men' who quite simply, thrive in all areas.

Attendance Matters

I am sure many of our families will have seen the recent media attention nationally regarding attendance. I have said many times that we aim for **every student to achieve 100% attendance** as we promote excellent habits for life. As part of this we appreciate every single conversation and action carried out by our parents/carers with students to promote the importance of attending school. We continue to **work together in partnership** to help each student to adopt the very best level of attendance. The attendance ladder below provides a really useful tool to help support and scaffold conversations with your son, both to celebrate excellence (green), and discuss any issues arising (orange/red). We currently have the highest whole school attendance recorded since 2018/2019, and remain well above national figures, it's a huge thank you from us all at Audenshaw school to all of our parents/carers for the continued support here — so far so good but we believe this can be even better. Our current in year school figure stands at **94.3%** which is significantly above the **91.4%** national average figure we attain through a database used by schools, this can only be achieved through excellent school/home agreements and continued collective messages of the importance of attending school. **We thank you for the key part you play in this.** Our figures place us well within the top 10% of schools' nationally and we know all too well the direct correlation between attending school and achievement in learning.

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Our Year 11 students returned this past week to the reality that this **is the final full term of their 5 year journey**. When we pause and reflect on this it really does 'hit home'. We want you to know we have never been so relentlessly driven to want the very best for all students especially at this stage, we know all too well just how vital this next term is for our oldest year group. They have only last week received revision packs, key messages of support, guidance and inspiration from their Year Leader Miss Butcher, and Pastoral Manager Miss Hall, alongside Mr Watt and many other year 11 staff members; the direction of travel is very clear – go for it! I am fortunate to lead such a **talented**, **hardworking and passionate teaching staffing team** who are best placed to guide all Year 11 students to their summer exams.
