and for some food. A great time was had by all!






A big well done to our Bronze and Silver Zero Heroes! These students have 100% attendance, no lates and no behaviour points!! Amazing!


On Monday 15th December all of our Piano students participated in the termly recital. Parents and carers, staff and students were in
